



Nairobi Jomo Kenyatta Airport- Directions

1. Once you have alighted from the international flight follow the directions for Baggage Collection and Passport Control.
2. First - you go to Passport Control
3. Second - you go to Baggage Collection (Downstairs)
4. Once you have been through immigration and you have collected your baggage you need to:

- Go out of the arrivals hall
- Through the glass doors
- Turn Left (past Barclays bank with ATM where we usually collect some KSH)
- Go outside and cross the car park and the road to domestic departures
- And the domestic departures is about 100yds away
- Tell the security that you are going to Kitale (they'll probably let you through, which saves you queuing) You check in at the Fly540 desk in the domestic terminal.

Notes

1. When you check in at London you cannot check through to Kitale. You check in at the Fly540 desk in the domestic terminal. Leave your international baggage tags on and say you are coming to IcFEM Mission so you should get 30kg free luggage allowance and then may have to pay for the extra.
2. Also when arriving on the early morning International flight try to get near the front to get off quickly as you may arrive at 6.30am with the Kitale flight leaving at 8am. Also alert the Stewards that you have a short connection time. Sometimes they send someone to rush you through.
3. You must clear and collect your luggage in Nairobi and take it across the road yourself.
4. Fly 540 phone number is :+254711558439. Phone them if you are delayed in the international baggage hall etc as they may well hold the Kitale plane for you.
