The above programme covered the whole of 2003 culminating in the Great Commissioning Conference held at Moi Girls School, Kamusinga in April 2004 during which certificates were issued to the participants.

Through the programme the following has happened:

- Great healing in the villages -- financial, family, and triumph over the power of darkness. Pastors no longer are dependent on church offerings but are now working with their own hand to generate income and feed the flock.
- The spirit of religiosity has been cancelled -- churches are now working together in intercession work and ministry.
- Pastors now work together covering each other's weaknesses. Gone are the days when pastors made fools of themselves trying to outdo each other all in the name of winning souls.
- Certificates awarded to the Shepherds and Church Leaders have been a powerful source of pride. Men and women, boys and girls, who would never have seen the inside of a Bible School now have certificates to show for their call.
- Pastors are now preaching the message of Christ instead of using the pulpit to tell stories. Now they know what a sermon is and the fire of the Holy Ghost is now flowing forth from the pulpit.
- Cultic and demonic forces have been weakened. Gone are the drums of the Dini ya Musombwa (this is an animistic local religion).

Because of the above, Misikhu Pastors and Church Leaders are requesting the second phase of the programme to kick off. This will now move the leaders on from the milk and meat of the Gospel to the bones.
