

## **IcFEM-Mission (Kenya) Beliefs, Objectives & Mission Statement.**

### **MISSION STATEMENT:**

**“Holy Living & Hard Work”**

### ***BELIEFS:***

That is to say:-

- a. That the Bible is the inspired Word of God, infallible, entirely trustworthy, and the supreme authority in all matters of faith and practice.
- b. That the Godhead eternally exists in the Trinity that is the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit one God, Creator of Heaven and Earth.
- c. That the salvation of lost and sinful man is through the shed blood of the Lord Jesus Christ, by grace through faith apart from works, and regeneration is by the Holy Spirit.
- d. That the full deity and true humanity of our Lord Jesus Christ, His personal pre-existence, His virgin birth, His sinless life, His miracles, His vicarious and atoning death, His bodily resurrection, His ascension, His mediatorial work, and His eventual personal return in power and glory are true.
- e. That the deity and personality of God is the Holy Spirit by whose work the sinner is converted and by whose indwelling the believer is enabled to live a holy life, to witness and to work for the Lord Jesus Christ.
- f. That the spiritual unity of all who, having believed in the Lord Jesus for their salvation, have been regenerated by the Holy Spirit comprise the one holy, universal church, the body of Christ of which He is the Head.
- g. That the primary business of the church and every Christian is to take the full Gospel of Jesus Christ to all creation and this is our Great Commission.
- h. That the local interdenominational Fellowship is a part of the universal church of Jesus Christ.
- i. That working hard to earn ones own living without compromising ones ‘holy life’ i.e. a Truthful, transparent and accountable/righteous living, hence our motto “HOLY LIVING AND HARD WORK” is a doctrine that should guide all human endeavour. – 1 Thessalonians 4:7 and 2 Thessalonians 3:10 – 12.
- j. That the biblical command to work righteously under any government in authority without being partisan to any political party or movement is correct and that any member of the Mission Board or Management who wishes to contest for political office shall resign on declaration of their interest, or nine months before the election date, whichever occurs earlier.

## **OBJECTIVES:**

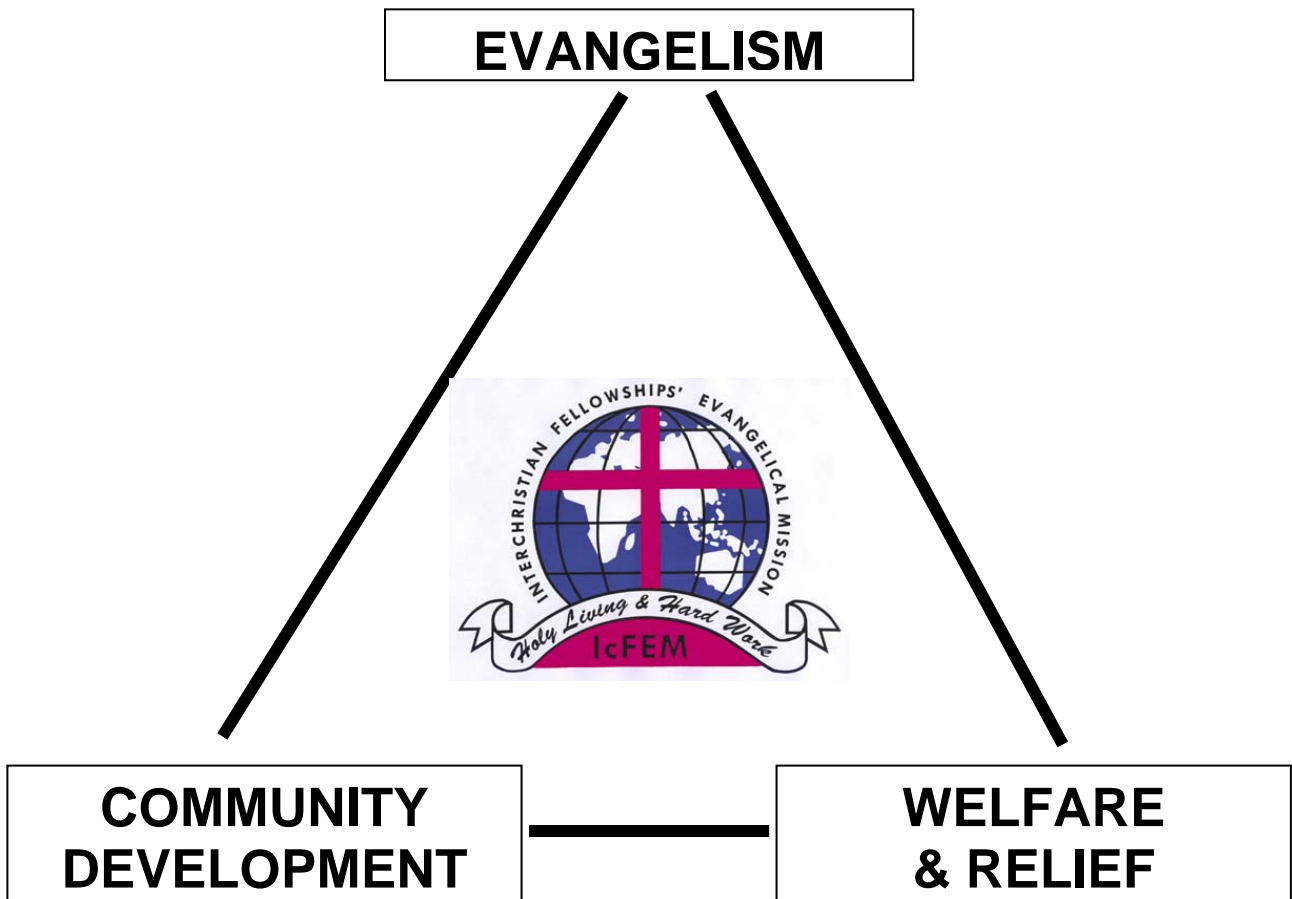
The three-fold objects for which the Mission is established shall be:-

- (i) Evangelism
- (ii) Community Development and
- (iii) Ministry to the Desperately Needy

The Mission shall be entirely charitable and non-political. (Not engaged in partisan politics)

These objectives are particularised as follows:-

- (a) To mobilize and prepare churches and church groups into becoming committed and effective Christians.
- (b) To empower church and church group leaders for effective leadership based on Biblical principles.
- (c) To enhance the integration of school leavers into the existing community-based spiritual and economic welfare programmes.
- (d) To seek to empower the target groups for increased productivity and self-sufficiency.
- (e) To seek to add the economic welfare concerns to the existing spiritual programmes run by other Christian ministries.
- (f) To give College and University Christian students an experience of working in the world of need.
- (g) To promote Mercy Ministries to the desperately needy in the community.
- (h) To raise educational standards in the community.
- (i) To harness and properly utilize the available natural resources for overall community development
- (j) To establish Mission centres and campuses through which services of Training/Conference Centres, Information and other Resource Centres/Libraries/Bookstalls, Orphanages, Health Facilities, Educational Establishments and Homes for the Elderly will be offered to the community.
- (k) To raise, mobilize and disburse funds and other resources for the promotion of the objects of the Mission.
- (l) To publish newsletters, brochures, periodicals, books and other publications as the Mission may deem desirable for the promotion of its objectives.
- (m) To establish groups, fellowships, chapters and branches inside and outside Kenya starting with Western Kenya, for the purpose of carrying out its objectives.
- (n) To promote the Kingdom of God.
